Find out about Beaver Scouts in another country. What do they call themselves? What is their uniform like? What do they say for their promise – is it different to ours? What does the country flag look like?

Make a collage or poster to show to your colony.

Cubs

Set off on a mission to develop your digital skills and explore another country – maybe one that you would like to visit in the future.

Use different websites to research the country – Kiddle or Fact Monster are good search engines to try.

You could find out what currency is used, the foods they eat or the language(s) they speak.

Choose a way to share this information with the rest of your pack – like a poster or leaflet.

Scouts

Explore scouting in another country. Does every country have scouts? How do they differ from UK scouts?

Some of the things you could compare are: Are they the same age as UK scouts? What is their uniform like? Do they have the same promise and laws? Do they have separate groups for girls and boys? What activities do they take part in? Where and when do they meet?

Share this information with your troop – if you all choose different countries you could chart on a map all the different countries that have been explored.

Explorers

Choose a country and explore their traditions and culture around food and dining. Are there special meals for festivals or events during the year?

Recreate a dining experience relating to your chosen country for your family. Try to make your family feel as though they are in that country – by adding decorations to the dining area for example.
