Travel Directions

Travelling eastbound on the A14 take the exit at junction 44 and then turn left taking the first exit off the roundabout.

Travelling westbound on the A14 take the exit at junction 44 and then turn right taking the third exit off the roundabout.

On exiting the roundabout at exit 44 take the next left onto Symonds Road and follow the road for 0.9 mile. (There is considerable traffic calming as you near the end of this road.) At the next roundabout take the first left onto Orttewell Road and travel for 0.3 mile to the next roundabout where you turn left onto Mount Road. Travel down Mount Road for 0.6 mile (the road narrows and becomes one way at the end), If the school gate is open (on the left) then enter here, otherwise, go on through the one-way and then turn left into Shakers Lane. A second entrance to the school is on the left 0.1 mile along Shakers Lane.

The Award

The Community Sports Leader Award in Archery is nationally recognised by Local Authorities, Youth organisations and Sports Centres as the minimum standard required to conduct an archery session.

The Course

The course is a mandatory minimum of 25 hours which participants must attend in full to qualify for assessment. Both the training course and the assessment is registered and approved by the Grand National Archery Society.

The Tutors

All the Tutors are experienced qualified coaches, specialising in Leader Certificate Training.

The Content

The Course covers

- All the safety rules of the sport
- How to lay out a shooting range
- How to conduct shooting sessions
- How to demonstrate a good shot
- The various shooting styles
- How to teach beginners
- Archery for those with special needs
- What equipment to buy
 - How to choose it
 - Where to buy it
 - How to maintain it
- Incentive Schemes
- The various forms of the sport

The Venue

The Course will be held at Priory School, Bury St Edmunds, Mount Road, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP32 7BH.

The range will be outside but you will be shooting from an undercover position if it rains.. Classroom work will be inside.

The Cost

The cost of the course will be £185 which will include all tuition and assessment fees, a course booklet, handouts and the use of all the equipment required, although you may bring a set of your own beginners equipment (20lbs drawn weight or less) if it is available.

Application and fee must be received not later than 22nd August 2014

An Email will be sent not later than 24th August 2014 to advise if you are accepted for the course, or if the course does not have enough participants to run.

A full refund can be made provided you cancel your application before 22nd August 2014. No refund can be made on or after that date.

What you need to bring

You will require a packed lunch but hot and cold drinks will be available.

It is preferable to wear a top with close fitting sleeves when shooting, but bring something warm for when outdoors but not shooting. You will need waterproofs with you in the case of wet weather.

Enclosed footwear will be required for the shooting range. (e.g. boots or shoes for outdoors, or trainers for indoors; but not sandals or open toed shoes).

Ladies are advised to wear trousers.

Candidates must attend the full course of 4 days to be eligible for assessment
