Suffolk Explorer Cruise 2016 – Weymouth to Falmouth via Channel Isles.

We have booked both of the Adventures Offshore sail training yachts - 'Ocean Scout' & 'Offshore Scout' - for the Weymouth to Falmouth leg of the Adventures Offshore 2016 Summer Cruise. We will be crossing the English Channel and calling at The Channel Islands. The crew will be made up entirely of Suffolk Scouts & Scouters.

Any Suffolk Explorer, Network or Leader – male or female – can apply for a berth if they are aged 15 or over on 29th July 2016.

- Depart from Ipswich by minibus Friday 29th July and travel to Weymouth.
- Return to Ipswich from Falmouth by minibus Saturday 6th Aug, arriving mid / late evening.
- Cost £240 per head which includes a berth, travel to & from Ipswich, food, use of good quality wet weather clothing, insurance and an embroidered micro fleece - but excludes personal spend.
- The cost is subsidised from several grant applications we have made.
- Allocation of a berth is not on a 'first come first served' basis. If there are more applications than berths on the closing date we will select candidates in Feb 2016.

Adventures Offshore have organised a series of Summer Cruises for both of their sail training yachts *Ocean Scout* & *Offshore Scout*. They will cruise in company through the summer starting & finishing in Ipswich and calling as far west as Ireland & The Scilly Isles.



The yachts are purpose built Oyster sail training yachts.



Set sail from Weymouth for the Channel Islands crossing the English Channel. If lucky, we will be accompanied by dolphins diving across our bow wave. Land on one of the many small islands which make up this enchanting archipelago. Refuel and replenish supplies at Jersey or Guernsey before re-crossing the English Channel. Enjoy anchoring or mooring in a Cornish port before finishing our cruise in the busy maritime centre of Falmouth.
