Resource

Pride Badge: LGBT+ Pairs Game

You will need:

- Template (see following pages)
- Printer
- Coloured paper/ thin card
- Scissors
- Laminator (optional)

To Make Your Cards:

1. Print the card templates on to coloured paper or thin card.
2. Laminate (optional) to protect them so they can be reused.
3. Cut the cards along the dotted lines to create one set.
4. Repeat for the number of teams you have to create one set per group.

All ages should discuss the terms and the definitions to check that everyone can recognise the words/symbols and understands their meanings. **Note:** Leaders may wish to reduce the number of cards to make the game easier for younger groups.

Option 1:

- Lay all the cards face down.
- Turning only 2 cards over at any time, find the pairs. If you are incorrect turn them back over.

Option 2:

- Lay all the cards face down at one end of the room.
- Sit in teams at the other end of the room. In a relay, take turns to run to the cards and turn over 2 cards.
- If you find a pair leave the cards face up, if you are incorrect turn them over.

Option 3:

- Give groups the pack of cards.
- First team to correctly match the key words and definitions wins.

LGBT+ Pairs Game Cards

Equality

Being the same (equal) in status, rights and/or opportunities

Diversity

Being different, having variety, being diverse.

Sex

Your physical form and biology. Generally used to assign (give) gender at birth.

Gender Identity

The way you feel, whether you want to identify as a boy, girl or something different.

Transgender

Someone who feels differently to the gender they were given at birth.

Non-binary

Someone who doesn't feel that they are either a boy or a girl.

Cisgender

A person whose gender matches the one they were given at birth.

Sexuality

A person's sexual orientation, the feelings that you have for someone you fancy.

Lesbian

A girl or woman who fancies (is attracted to) other girls or women.

Gay

A boy or man who fancies (is attracted to) other boys or men. Sometimes used to describe lesbians.

Bisexual

A person who fancies a range of people. For example; a man who is attracted to other men and women.

Straight or Heterosexual

A girl or woman who fancies boys or men OR a boy or man who fancies girls or women.

Pansexual

A person who fancies anyone of any gender and doesn't believe that gender is important.

A-Sexual

Someone who doesn't fancy others.
