
Travel Directions

Traveling west along the A14 from Bury St Edmunds turrn off at junction 40 for Higham and Barrow. At the end of the slip road turn left onto Coalpit Lane.

Traveling east along the A14 from New Market, turn off at junction 40 for Higham and Barrow. At the end of the slip road turn right onto Coalpit Lane.

Travel south over the railway for 1.7 mile and tun leftt into Church Road (signposted for Risby), and after a further 0.5 mile, by the church, the Academy is on the left.

From Haverhill follow the A143 Wratting Road. At Depend, turn left into Church End and after 1 mile, turn right at the T-junction with Wickhambrook Road. Follow the road for 4.1 miles (through several name changes) through Barrow where you turn right by the school into Church Road (signposted for Risby). After a further 0.5 mile, by the church, the Academy is on the left.

The Award

The Community Sports Leader Award in Archery is nationally recognised by Local Authorities, Youth organisations and Sports Centres as the minimum standard required to conduct an archery session.

The Course

The course is a mandatory minimum of 25 hours which participants must attend in full to qualify for assessment. Both the training course and the assessment is registered and approved by the Grand National Archery Society.

The Tutors

All the Tutors are experienced qualified coaches, specialising in Leader Certificate Training.

The Content

The Course covers

- All the safety rules of the sport
- How to lay out a shooting range
- How to conduct shooting sessions
- How to demonstrate a good shot
- The various shooting styles

- What equipment to buy How to choose it Where to buy it How to maintain it

- The various forms of the sport

The Venue

The Course will be held at The Academy, Church Road, Barrow, Bury St Edmunds, IP29 5AX. The range will be outdoors, but classroom work will be inside.

The Cost

The cost of the course will be £180 which will include all tuition and assessment fees, a course booklet, handouts and the use of all the equipment required, although you may bring a set of your own beginners equipment if it is available.

Application and fee must be received not later than 10th January 2013

Mail will be sent not later than 12th January 2013 to advise if you are accepted for the course, or if the course does not have enough participants to run.

A full refund can be made provided you cancel your application before 10th January 2013. No refund can be made on or after that date.

What you need to bring

You will require a packed lunch but hot and cold drinks will be available.

It is preferable to wear a top with close fitting sleeves when shooting, but bring something warm for when not shooting.

Ladies are advised to wear trousers

As shooting will be on an outside range for the duration of the course bring a lightweight waterproof.

Enclosed footwear will be required for the shooting range. (e.g. boots, shoes, trainers but not sandals or open toed shoes))

Candidates must attend the full course of 4 days to be eligible for assessment
