Most phones will let you record video or audio but those of you that love to play with technology could try downloading **Audacity**, it's a free tool for making podcasts and is a good place to start developing your skills.

Whatever you create start by introducing yourself by your first name only and tell us the section you are in and which Scout Group you are part of and then go for it. Try

and get 'Skills for life' in your vlog / podcast, and at the very end make sure you say how much you love Suffolk Scouts and say '#adventurecontinues.'
